Peter Kupfer is Associate Professor of Musicology at Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Chicago with a dissertation on the Soviet musical comedy films of Grigory Aleksandrov and Isaak Dunayevsky. His research employs historical and empirical methods to analyze the perception and reception of music, ideology, and moving images, with particular interests in Soviet (film) music as well as classical music in popular media and advertising.
