 Linguistics is about our capacity to make something we call 'language' from various cognitive resources.

 Semantics is about our capacity to make something we call 'meanings' from various cognitive resources.





# **Grammar = Language Faculty**

Allows humans to construct complex meanings from different cognitive resources.

Allows humans to make their thoughts audible or visible so that they can be shared with others.

# A technology that interacts with vast knowledge resources



### Sampler of products

 Notions like 'agent', 'cause', 'goal' are used to make argument structure.

 Interrogative pronouns are used to make quantifier constructions.

 Prosody is used to structure discourse: what is given information, what's new, what contrasts with what?

### Questions

 What's uniform, what's variable in the construction of meanings across languages, spoken or signed?

 How is the interaction between grammar and other cognitive modules represented in the brain? And how does it develop in children?
