Formatting Text with Character Tags

If you've used publishing software such as Microsoft Word or Adobe InDesign, you might be familiar with the concept of styles. FrameMaker has a similar function called tags. A tag is just a collection of formatting settings that you can apply to text. If you change the settings of a tag, all text with that tag will change according. Character tags are used to format just certain characters within a paragraph.

Applying a Character Tag to Text

1. Click Format > Characters > Catalog. The Character catalog panel opens.
